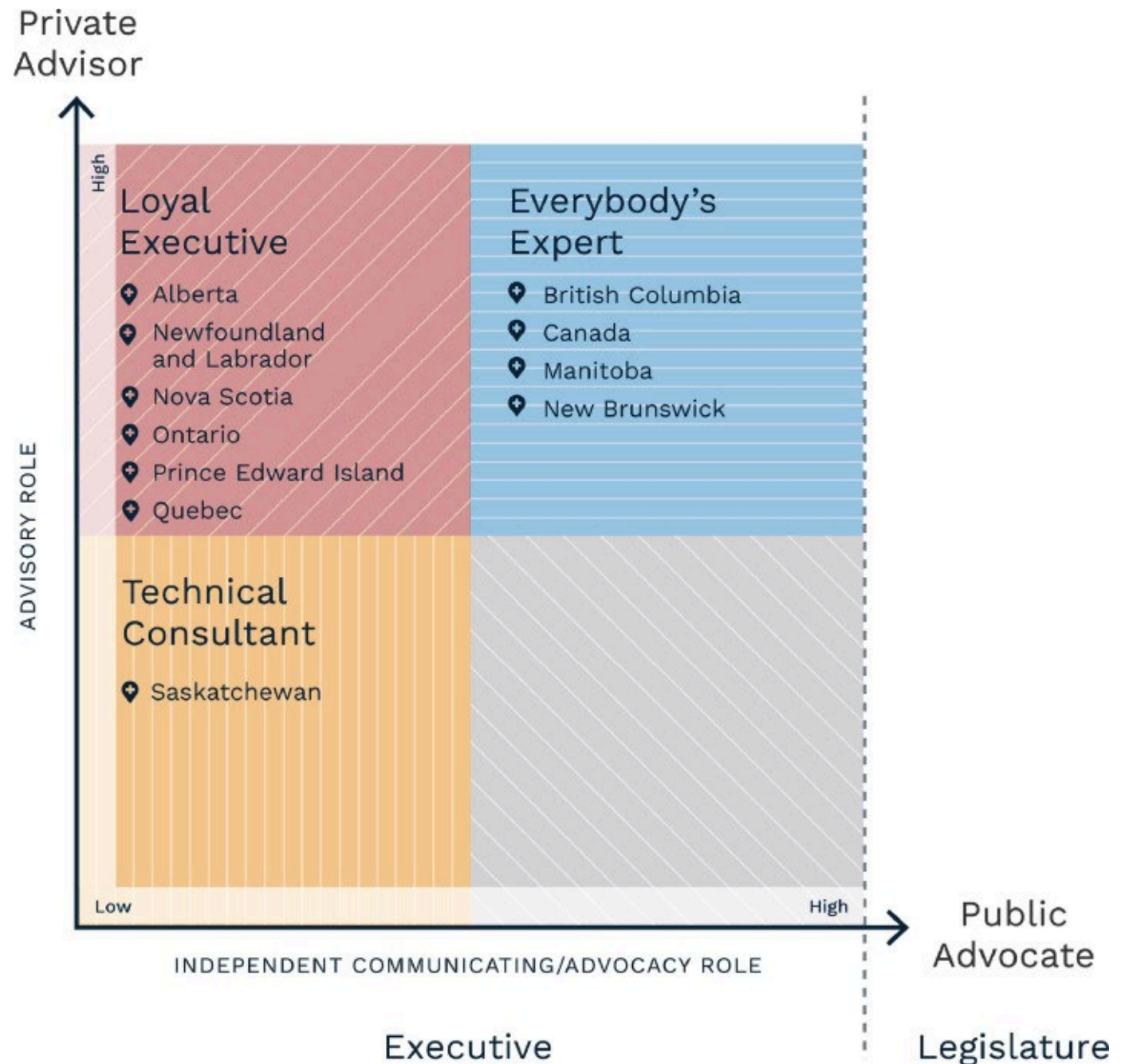
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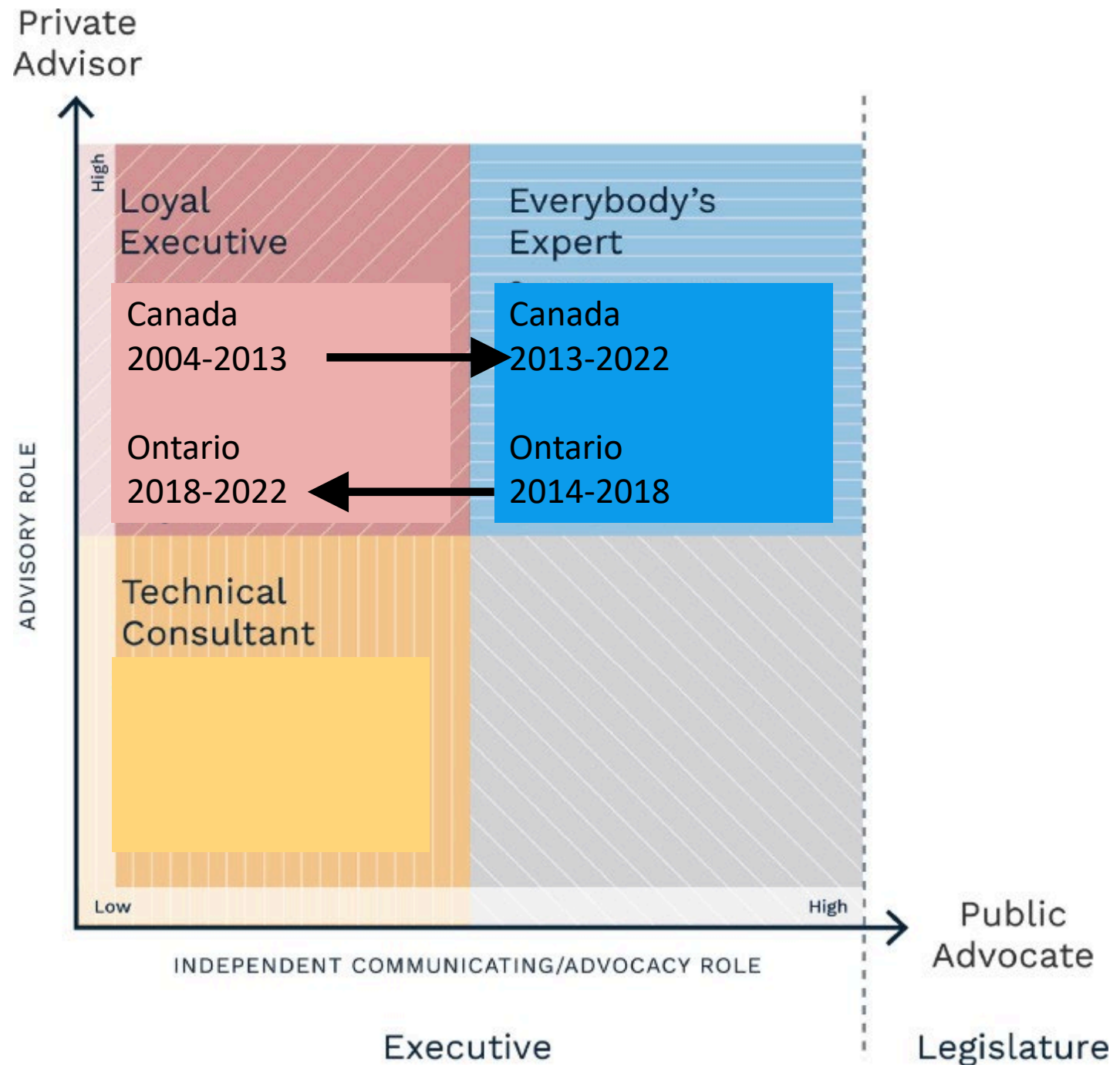

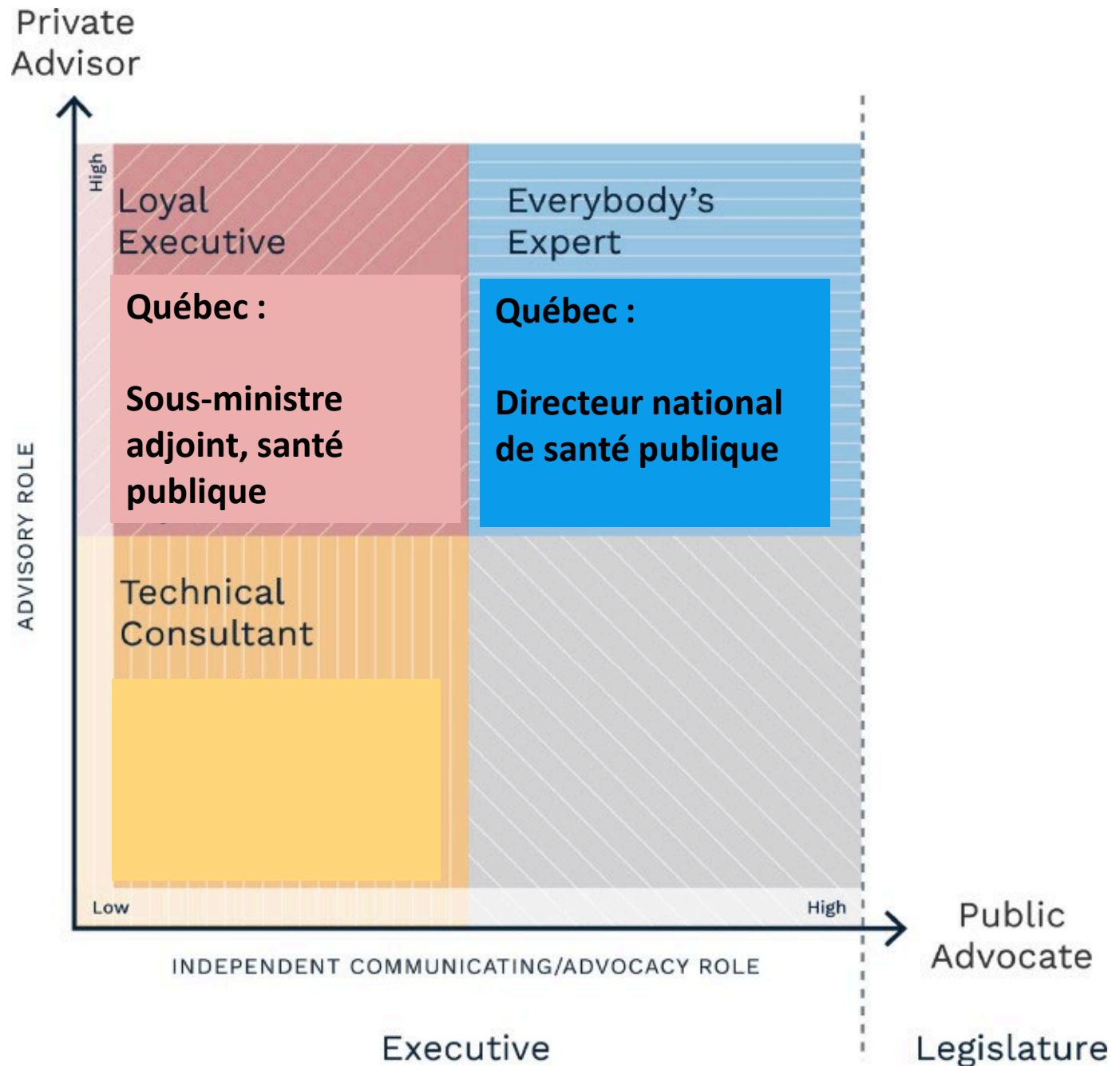


2. MHEC au Canada : évolution



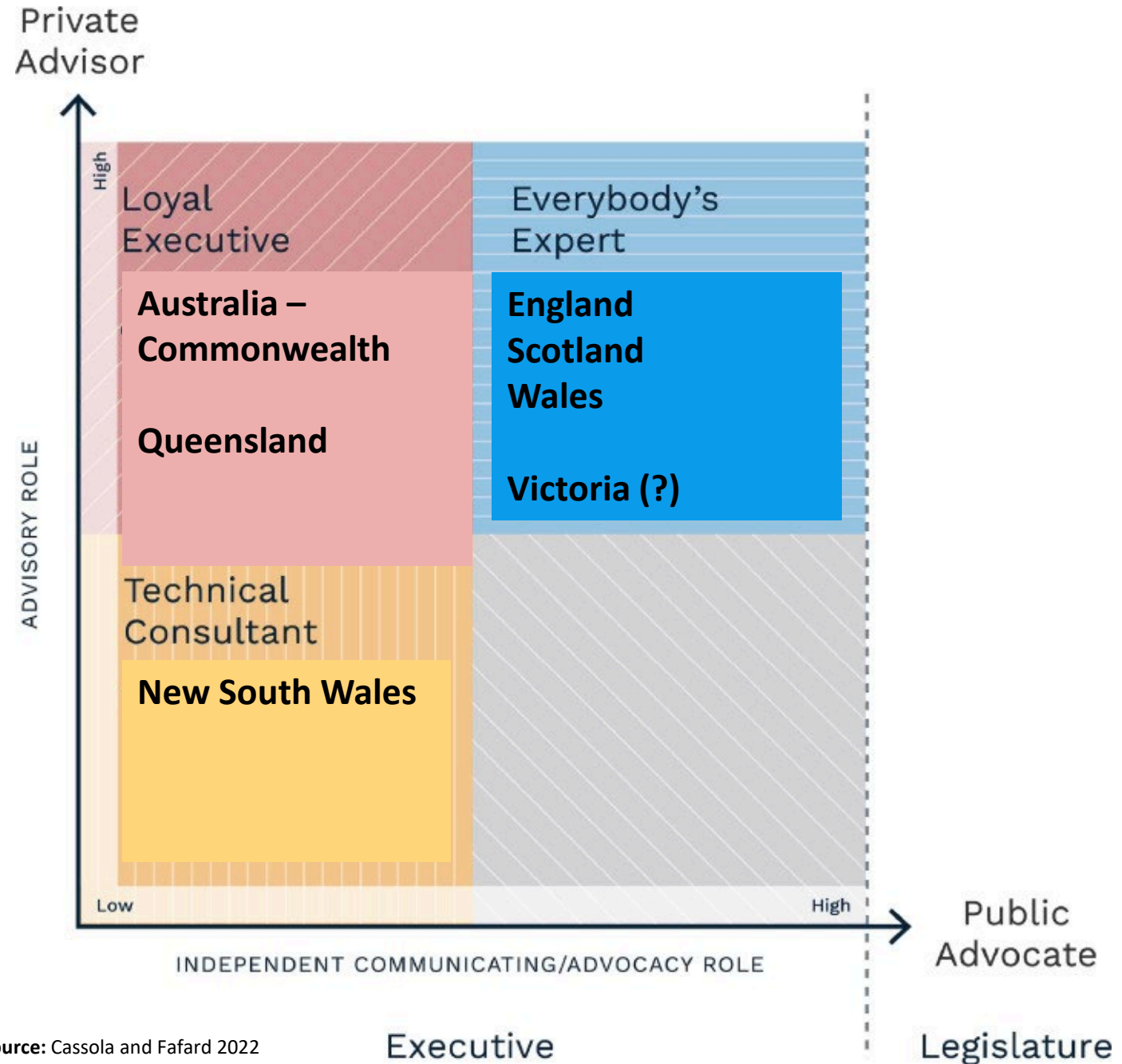

Pandemic re-orders the importance of CMOH roles

	Pre-pandemic	Pandemic
1. Advisor	Medium	High
2. “Explainer in chief”	Medium	Very High
3. Government spokesperson	Low-medium	Very High
4. Public Health Executive	Medium	Low
5. Public health advocate	Medium	Low
6. Regulator with statutory authority	Low	Very High

5. Réformes



“When designing the role [of CMOH], governments must balance trade-offs and consider desired outcomes.”

5. Réformes : indépendance



To maximize autonomy and public credibility

- Split the role of CMOH and ADM Public Health
- Transparency on the science informing CMOH advice
- Strengthen autonomy of local/regional MOH
- Enhance the accountability of the CMOH to the legislature (as in Australia)

5. Réformes : influence



To maximize influence

- Combine the role of CMOH and ADM Public Health
- Strong linkage CMOH and public health agency (e.g., INSPQ; PHO, BC-CDC)
- Centralize authority / reduce autonomy of local MOH
